what he says.

'Epilepsy research is still on going and the research remains on going in the search to find an accurate test to benefit both humans and animals affected by this problem. Being such a complex disease it has now been found that a tool to assist breeders is at a stand still due to the fact it has been seen that more than one gene is the cause of the problem. Advice given at this stage by the researcher not to breed from animals who have affected animals in their litter or in the pedigree.

'To really look at a pedigree before one uses it. To ask questions as to why that one animal suddenly had a seizure and if in doubt do not breed from that line or animal.' 048 A048 30. II.
